Form 2 students also find time to get more involved on campus, taking leadership positions in clubs, serving as prefects, entering competitions, or working on campus.

### EFAC Community Bonds: School Visits

EFAC students are visited by our staff and volunteer mentors. EFAC Peer Mentors are EFAC scholars in post-secondary school who have been trained as mentors, providing a familiar source of support for younger students. These visits ensure that students are adjusting to school life and progressing academically.

### Bridge-to-Success Workshop

Students gather during a school break in Nairobi for the 5-day Bridge-to-Success Workshop. While themes and activities vary each year, workshops always emphasize leadership, social skills, time management, study habits, and health & wellness.
